Cllr Tippen attended the KALC Area Committee last night when an MBC Officer was in attendance. It was reported 2215 representations for Regulation 19 (less than Reg 18) had been received. MBC will be making some major modifications which will go to SPI meeting on 21st March 2022. Further work is being undertaken on garden communities in regard to design, drainage etc. It is envisaged that the Inspector will have started work in May with hearings being received late Summer.

216/22 MARDEN NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

Meeting of Cllrs held 22nd January 2022.

Notes had been circulated and it was agreed in principle that the MNP would be reviewed in light of Maidstone Borough Local Plan. It was discussed that it would be reviewed in 2 phases (1) in light of updates from NPPF/conformity of policies; and (2) in depth review including an Open Day to be held on 7th May 2022. A meeting is to be held on 24th February at 7.30pm with Cllrs to discuss the format of the open day. The poster was agreed and this would now be publicised via the newsletter, social media and notice boards. Following the open day a meeting would be held for the community to attend and become involved with taking the MNP forward.

Notification had been received from MBC regarding the review process and this would be discussed at the meeting on the 24th February.
