(c) 15/509377/FULL - 1 Howland Road, Marden

Introduction of a gate in an existing fence – Revised details Cllrs noted that the applicant has now provided a revised plan appearing to show the proposed gate's position onto Barnes Walk and a Certificate B from the relevant landowner being the Highway Authority.

(d) 16/500480/FULL - Elm View, Thorn Road

Conversion of detached garage to be used as ancillary to the main dwelling. Cllrs note that the garage appears to be partially converted already but no record of a planning application has been found. However, Cllrs have no objection to the application provided that it is used only for purposes ancillary to the main dwelling and not as a separate hereditament or as a holiday let.
